



March 23, 2022 – Statement

On March 21, 2022, the U.S. government announced that it had determined that the Myanmar military committed genocide and crimes against humanity against the Rohingya ([Announcement](#)).

Blood Money Campaign urges the US government to ensure transitional justice for Rohingya after this important announcement.

Hundreds of millions of dollars in revenues from natural gas projects, including from Chevron – a US corporation – are still funding the junta – supporting it in committing genocide, war crimes, and crimes against humanity in Myanmar. They have been since Feb 1, 2021.

We urge the Biden administration to enact sanctions against MOGE immediately to cut off the flow of gas revenue blood money, paid in US dollars. The criminal, genocidal junta can use it to buy arms, fighter jets, and bombs for airstrikes.

We urge all international corporations to stop doing business with genocidaires. Companies like Chevron, TotalEnergies, and POSCO don't have to diverst, but they must stop treating the junta like a legitimate government and ignoring options to divert revenues from the junta.
